DIRECTIONS FOR CLEANING FILTER HOUSINGS

Wear protective clothing for hand, eye and respiratory protection.

- 1) Spray Puretec HC750 on the inside surface of the filter housing after removing the filter cartridge.
- 2) Leave the solution applied to the surface for 1 minute.
- 3) Rinse with cold water.
- 4) Wipe the surface with a wet cloth.
- 5) Rinse the surface for at least 1 minute.
- 6) To remove more embedded dirt, mineral build up or discolouration ensure all surfaces are well covered with HC750 and leave for 5 minutes.
- 7) Repeat steps 3 - 5.

INHALATION: Remove victim from exposure. Remove contaminated clothing and loosen remaining clothing. Allow patient to assume most comfortable position. Keep at rest until fully recovered. Seek medical advice if effects persist.

SKIN CONTACT: If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. If swelling, redness, blistering or irritation occurs seek medical assistance. For skin burns or skin irritation, cover with a clean, dry dressing until medical help is available.

EYE CONTACT: Immediately irrigate with copious quantities of water for 15 minutes. Eyelids to be held open. Remove clothing if contaminated and wash skin. Urgently seek medical assistance. Transport to hospital or medical centre.

INGESTION: Rinse mouth with water. If swallowed, do NOT induce vomiting. Give a glass of water to drink. Never give anything by the mouth to an unconscious patient. If vomiting occurs give further water. Seek medical advice.
